Spruce Tree Bagworm Alert

If you have evergreen trees or shrubs in your landscape, you may want to examine them. If they have little bags about 2 inches long & are roughly diamond shaped & look like they are made out of pine needles, they are bagworms (See picture above).

Bagworms are not a serious problem if controlled, but over the course of several years they can kill a tree & spread to others if not controlled. They usually start hatching around late May. Chemical treatment should start around late June so that most of the bagworms have hatched but are still susceptible to the insecticide. Hand pulling the bags is an option...crush them, immerse in soapy water, rubbing alcohol or kerosene & then dispose of them. Check with your local arborist for further details. (Per Nebraska Extension Service)
