#### **Current HOA Board Work**

Your five member board has several improvement projects underway as well as the routine work of the board. This fall, the long term tree replacement program will be seen with the planting of trees in the Green space along Blue Sage and between 200th Street & Avenue. This green space has been reseeded to reestablish the turf. The formal land title transfer is in progress, pending developer remedial actions for the unauthorized use of the land, while the title transfer of the entry green space to the HOA has been completed. Our SID owns the title and is maintaining the green space at Blue Sage and HWS Cleveland.

Led by the super energy and volunteerism of members Mike Ancona and Craig Strutzel, an updated website is in the later stages of development. The site update will be completed Fall, 2018. The new site will be more informational and will contain various policies and procedures. The new site is also designed to better market our neighborhood to potential home seekers and realtors.
